

How to Disable Comments

Settings -> Discussion

For the **New posts**

De-check:


"Allow people to submit comments on new posts"

For **Site-wide**

Check:

Automatically close comments on posts older than [] days

(and set that to 1 days if you want to be 100% sure no old post has comments still enabled.)

 - Enable threaded (nested) comments
 - Number of levels for threaded (nested) comments
- Comment Pagination**
 - Break comments into pages
 - Top level comments per page
 - Comments page to display by default
 - Comments to display at the top of each page
- Email me whenever**
 - Anyone posts a comment
 - A comment is held for moderation
- Before a comment appears**
 - Comment must be manually approved
 - Comment author must have a previously approved comment
